SCRIPTURE READINGS FOR PRAYER AND PREPARATION Genesis 1:1-5; Psalm 29; Mark 1:4-11 (Congregants are encouraged to read and reflect upon these passages as they prepare for worship.)

*PRAYER OF INVOCATION AND CONFESSION (unison) God of all glory, Creator, Lord, and Savior, on this first day of Your creating power You brought light out of darkness. On this first Sunday of Your new year You gather us in promise and in hope. On this first day of a new week You bring us together in fellowship and worship to celebrate new life in our risen Lord. Yet even as we lift our voices in praise and thanksgiving, we confess that we enter 2024 with fear and division. We have not loved You with our whole heart, mind, and spirit, and we have not loved our neighbors as ourselves. In Your mercy, forgive what we have been, help us to grow in You and to amend what we are, and direct what we shall become through Your Holy Spirit, so that we may follow where You lead. Hear these our silent prayers.

*ASSURANCE OF FORGIVENESS The mercy of the Lord is from everlasting to everlasting. Anyone who is in Christ is a new creation. Know that you are forgiven, and be at peace, in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. Praise be to God!

THE FIRST READING OF GOD'S WORD Isaiah 60:1-6

¹Arise, shine; for your light has come, and the glory of the Lord has risen upon you. ² For darkness shall cover the earth, and thick darkness the peoples; but the Lord will arise upon you, and his glory will appear over you. ³ Nations shall come to your light, and kings to the brightness of your dawn. ⁴ Lift up your eyes and look around; they all gather together, they come to you; your sons shall come from far away, and your daughters shall be carried on their nurses' arms. ⁵ Then you shall see and be radiant; your heart shall thrill and rejoice, because the abundance of the sea shall be brought to you, the wealth of the nations shall come to you. ⁶ A multitude of camels shall cover you, the young camels of Midian and Ephah; all those from Sheba shall come. They shall bring gold and frankincense, and shall proclaim the praise of the Lord.

THE SECOND READING OF GOD'S WORD Matthew 2:1-12, 16

¹In the time of King Herod, after Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judea, wise men from the East came to Jerusalem, ²asking, 'Where is the child who has been born king of the Jews? For we observed his star at its rising, and have come to pay him homage.' ³When King Herod heard this, he was frightened, and all Jerusalem with him; ⁴and calling together all the chief priests and scribes of the people, he inquired of them where the Messiah was to be born. ⁵They told him, 'In Bethlehem of Judea; for so it has been written by the prophet: ⁶ "And you, Bethlehem, in the land of Judah, are by no means least among the rulers of Judah; for from you shall come a ruler who is to shepherd my people Israel." '⁷ Then Herod secretly called for the wise men and learned from them the exact time when the star had appeared. ⁸Then he sent them to Bethlehem, saying, 'Go and search diligently for the child; and when you have found him, bring me word so that I may also go and pay him homage.' ⁹When they had heard the king, they set out; and there, ahead of them, went the star that they had seen at its rising, until it stopped over the place where the child was. ¹⁰When they saw that the star had stopped, they were overwhelmed with joy. ¹¹On entering the house, they saw the child with Mary his mother; and they knelt down and paid him homage. Then, opening their treasure-chests, they offered him gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh. ¹²And having been warned in a dream not to return to Herod, they left for their own country by another road.

¹⁶ When Herod saw that he had been tricked by the wise men, he was infuriated, and he sent and killed all the children in and around Bethlehem who were two years old or under, according to the time that he had learned from the wise men
