GATHER JOYFULLY

THE PRELUDE

SCRIPTURE READINGS FOR PRAYER AND PREPARATION Mark 11:1-11; John 12:2-16; Psalm 118:19-29 (Congregants are encouraged to read and reflect upon these passages as they prepare for worship.)

BUILDING THE BODY OF CHRIST May the hope that is ours in Christ be with you.

GATHERING HYMN 197 *Hosanna, Loud Hosanna* (Verses 1 and 2) Hosanna, loud hosanna, the little children sang; through pillared court and temple the joyful anthem rang. To Jesus, who had blessed them, close folded to his breast, the children sang their praises, the simplest and the best.

From Olivet they followed 'mid an exultant crowd, the victor palm branch waving, and chanting clear and loud; the Lord of earth and heaven rode on in lowly state, nor scorned that little children should on his bidding wait.

THE CALL TO WORSHIP (Responsive, from Zechariah 9:9)
Minister: Blessed is the one who comes in the name of the Lord.
Congregants: Hosanna in the highest!
Minister: Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion!
Congregants: Shout aloud, O daughter of Jerusalem!
Minister: Lo, your king comes to you.
Congregants: Triumphant and victorious is he.
Minister: He comes in humility, riding on a donkey.

Congregants: He rides a colt, the foal of a donkey.

Minister: He comes today, so let us worship our God.

*PRAYER OF INVOCATION AND CONFESSION (unison) Merciful God, as we enter Holy Week and gather now in worship, turn our hearts again to Jerusalem, to the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ, so that united with him and with all the faithful, we may one day enter in triumph the city not made by human hands, the new Jerusalem, eternal in the heavens, and live with You in glory. In our sinfulness and brokenness, we seek Your forgiveness, and ask for Your mercy. Give us the same mind that was in Christ, that we might obey Your will and follow Your path. Hear these our silent prayers.

*ASSURANCE OF FORGIVENESS (from I John 4:9) In this is love, not just that we loved God, but that God loved us and sent His Son into this world, so that we might live and be saved through Him. Hear the good news: in Jesus Christ, we are forgiven!

*RESPONSE HYMN 1 97 Hosanna, Loud Hosanna (Verse 3) Hosanna in the highest!" That ancient song we sing, for Christ is our Redeemer; the Lord of heaven, our King. O may we ever praise him with heart and life and voice, and in his blissful presence eternally rejoice.

THE FIRST READING OF GOD'S WORD Philippians 2:5-11

⁵Let the same mind be in you that was in Christ Jesus, ⁶who, though he was in the form of God, did not regard equality with God as something to be exploited, ⁷ but emptied himself, taking the form of a slave, being born in human likeness. And being found in human form, ⁸ he humbled himself and became obedient to the point of death—even death on a cross. ⁹ Therefore God also highly exalted him and gave him the name that is above every name, ¹⁰so that at the name of Jesus every knee should bend, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, ¹¹and every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

MESSAGE FOR YOUNG DISCIPLES

THE SECOND READING OF GOD'S WORD Luke 19:29-44

²⁹ When he had come near Bethphage and Bethany, at the place called the Mount of Olives, he sent two of the disciples, ³⁰saying, 'Go into the village ahead of you, and as you enter it you will find tied there a colt that has never been ridden. Untie it and bring it here. ³¹If anyone asks you, "Why are you untying it?" just say this: "The Lord needs it." ³²So those who were sent departed and found it as he had told them. ³³As they were untying the colt, its owners asked them, 'Why are you untying the colt?' ³⁴They said, 'The Lord needs it.' ³⁵Then they brought it to Jesus; and after throwing their cloaks on the colt, they set Jesus on it. ^{36As} he rode along, people kept spreading their cloaks on the road. ³⁷As he was now approaching the path down from the Mount of Olives, the whole multitude of the disciples began to praise God joyfully with a loud voice for all the deeds of power that they had seen, ³⁸saying, 'Blessed is the king who comes in the name of the Lord! Peace in heaven, and glory in the highest heaven!' ³⁹Some of the Pharisees in the crowd said to him, 'Teacher, order your disciples to stop.' ⁴⁰He answered, 'I tell you, if these were silent, the stones would shout out.' ⁴¹As he came near and saw the city, he wept over it, ⁴²saying, 'If you, even you, had

only recognized on this day the things that make for peace! But now they are hidden from your eyes. ⁴³Indeed, the days will come upon you, when your enemies will set up ramparts around you and surround you, and hem you in on every side. ⁴⁴They will crush you to the ground, you and your children within you, and they will not leave within you one stone upon another; because you did not recognize the time of your visitation from God.'

Speak to us through the sacrifice and the victory of Jesus Christ, so that we might receive grace and strength to share his love in lives given to Your service. Through his name we pray. Amen.
